The 29-year-old, who won silver at the 2022 Para-Badminton World Championships, gave the other official Japanese opponent in the bronze medal race, the SL3 category is for players with movement/moderately affected use of the left hand, both hands, or the shoulder. They play standing on a solid court surface and have moderate movement but a wide range of shot strokes typical to Group A with three successive wins to progress to the semifinal along with Thailand's Mongkol Bunnin from the same group. In the final, Karimov will battle on Great Britain's Daniel Bethell in the gold medal match on Monday.

## **Scottie Scheffler caps dominant year with FedEx Cup title and \$25m payday**

London, September 02 : T. inevitable became official Sunday afternoon at the Lake Golf Club; Sentinel Schieffer won the Tom Championship and clinched the 2024 FedEx Cup, the season-long championship of his PGA Tour career. Schieffer finished shopping 30 under par, defeating Adam Anderson in a four-strikes after an opening round of 4-under 67. The world No. 1 added a FedEx Cup to his growing resume and took home the corresponding \$5 million bonus. Schieffer made up a deficit of 10 strokes to get back-to-back top-10 finishes by piping off three birdies in a row on Nos. 9-11. A 15-foot eagle putt at the par-4 14th was the final highlight of Schieffer's commanding 2024 campaign that reasserted his status as the best golfer in the world. Anderson applied pressure early on to maintain a lead, but he
